JBR to Enter Monza Sprint Round of Italian GT with Ferrari 296 GT3



JBR announces it will enter the Ferrari 296 GT3 in the season finale of the Italian GT Sprint Championship at Monza (October 4-6), the premier GT championship in Italy. JBR, a racing team founded by Tomonobu Fujii for gentlemen drivers, will compete in the GT3 AM class with two experienced Japanese Bronze drivers.

Shortly after its launch in June 2024, JBR competed in Japan Cup organized by the SRO of GT World Challenge Asia. JBR won the GT4 AM class twice with gentlemen drivers who made their own racing debut and teamed up for the first time at the circuit.

In affiliation with simdrive, Japan's first members-only driving lab, JBR will continue to fully support the passion of numerous gentlemen drivers who are looking to enter the world of motorsports racing.
